Future Stars in HR Scholarship Awards

The Awards

For over 15 years, NEHRA has provided scholarship assistance to college students in New England who are preparing for careers in human resources.

Up to two awards in the amount of \$2,500 each and one in the amount of \$3,000. In addition, each awardee will receive a one-year NEHRA student membership.

Future Stars in HR 2008 scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Full-time undergraduate or graduate student in good standing in an accredited college or university during the 2008-2009 academic year
- An interest in becoming a human resources professional, as evidenced by having successfully completed at least one college-level course with relevance to the field
- Academic success, as evidenced by having maintained a 3.0/4.0 grade point average
- Leadership skills, as evidenced by previous success as a leader
- Significant participation in non-academic activities, either on campus or in the community

Required Attachments

- Resume (Please include extra curricular activities and community service.)
- Official transcript
- Two (2) letters of recommendation one of which must be a faculty member
- Two one-page essays answering the following questions:
 1. Why are you interested in becoming a human resources professional? What related qualities do you currently possess? What qualities do you need to acquire and how do you intend to do so?
 2. Please describe the most important contribution HR can make to the success of an organization

Application Process

All applications, including required attachments, must be postmarked no later than March 7, 2008 and mailed to the following address:

John D. Erdlen Scholarship Award
